Most aerial fiber optic cables are installed by lashing to a steel messenger wire strung between poles, but there is a category of cables with special high-strength jacket designs called all-dielectric self-supporting (ADSS) cables. ADSS cables are designed to withstand very high-tension loads. For monitoring and managing networks, they use a variety of means of communications, including running fiber optic cables along the transmission and distribution towers, radio links and contracting landline and cellular communications services from telecom carriers. Outdoor cable may be direct buried, pulled or blown into conduit or innerduct, or installed aerially between poles.
