

The 10 Gigabit optical port can be used to connect a gigabit module

Using a 10G SFP+ module on a 1G SFP port is not supported due to rate mismatch and lack of auto-negotiation for optical signals. To ensure stable and efficient network communication, it is important to match the optical module speed with the port speed. Using mismatched modules may work in some cases but will not utilize the full bandwidth of the 10G module.

Summary 10G SFP+ port + 1G SFP module → works at 1 Gbps
1G SFP port + 10G SFP+ module → does not work
Always verify switch specifications and dual-rate support before connecting different-speed modules to avoid network issues. This ensures proper operation and avoids potential rate mismatches or link failures in fiber-optic networks.
