- Faulty Breaker Switches:** Mechanical failure or worn components in a breaker can cause it to vibrate under load, often producing a mid-frequency buzzing sound.
- Water Damage or Corrosion:** Moisture in the panel can corrode wires, increasing resistance and causing buzzing. This is a serious hazard and requires immediate attention.

Do not attempt repairs yourself unless you are a qualified electrician. Listen carefully to localize the noise. If it comes from a single breaker, that unit may be faulty. If the entire panel hums loudly, the...
