Pull Boxes and Conduit Bends For long conduit runs or multiple bends, pull boxes are essential to facilitate wire installation and prevent cable damage. According to NEC Article 314.28, pull boxes must be sized based on the largest raceway entering the box: straight pulls require a minimum length of 8 times the trade size of the largest conduit, while angle pulls require 6 times plus the sum of other raceways on the same wall . Pull boxes also allow for future maintenance, cable replacement, or system upgrades without removing the entire conduit run . Grounding and Bonding Any metallic conduit carrying a grounding or bonding conductor must be bonded at both ends using a #6 AWG or larger insulated ground wire to ensure electrical safety . This prevents potential differences between the conduit and the distribution box, reducing the risk of electrical shock or equipment damage.
