Overview of Three-Level Protection

It involves three tiers of distribution boxes: primary, secondary, and tertiary, each serving a specific role in controlling and protecting electrical circuits. The system follows the principle of "one machine, one switch, one protection, one box, one lock", preventing a single switch from controlling multiple devices.

Levels of Distribution Boxes

- 1. Primary Distribution Box (Level I)** Connects directly to the transformer or main power supply. Equipped with Air Circuit Breakers (ACB) with short-time delay for selective coordination. Handles high current and short-circuit protection, typically rated 1.2–1.5 times the transformer capacity. Features copper busbars, metering systems, and rainproof tops for outdoor use.
- 2. Secondary Distribution Box (Level II)** Receives power from the primary box and distributes it to sub-circuits. Uses Molded-Case Circuit Breakers (MCCBs), either thermomagnetic for general loads or electronic for precise protection and communication. Ensures selective protection in coordination with the primary ACB. Often designed with inner and outer doors, powder-coated exteriors, and rainproof tops for safety and aesthetics.
- 3. Tertiary Distribution Box (Level III)** The final junction box for individual electrical appliances or equipment. Uses Miniature Circuit Breakers (MCBs) and Residual Current Devices (RCDs/RCBOs) for leakage protection...
