Aisle Containment and Airflow

Micro-modules use closed aisle designs to isolate hot and cold airflows:

- Closed cold aisle:** Front of racks is enclosed to prevent cold air from mixing with room air
- Closed hot aisle:** Rear of racks is enclosed to capture hot exhaust air for efficient removal

This containment ensures short, efficient airflow cycles, reduces cooling energy loss, and allows precise temperature control within the module.

Rack and Cabinet Layout

Cabinets are often grouped in triplets or six-cabinet micro-modules. Top-mounted air conditioners or cooling units are positioned above the racks. Cable trays are installed above the cooling modules for organized cabling. The layout supports plug-and-play deployment, with pre-installed power and network interfaces.

Power and Monitoring

Each micro-module has an independent power system, which can include UPS or HVDC 240V DC. Modules can be powered by different systems within the same room, allowing mixed power configurations. Monitoring systems provide real-time data on temperature, humidity, and equipment status, with remote web interface access for...
