Router compatibility: Ensure your router has a Gigabit Ethernet WAN port and supports the speeds of your fiber plan. Wi-Fi 6 or 6E routers are recommended for optimal performance.

Using your router with the ISP router: If your ISP provides a router integrated with the ONT, you can either use your router in bridge mode or as an access point to extend Wi-Fi coverage. By following these steps, you can use a router without a fiber port while still taking full advantage of your fiber internet connection.
