**Speed and Interface Matching:** Ensure the optical module's data rate matches the switch port. For example, a 10G module should not be used on a 1G interface.

**Vendor Compatibility:** Some switches require modules to be recognized in the switch's compatibility code. Newer switch models may need updated firmware or specific module codes to operate correctly.

**Monitoring and Status Verification**

Switches provide tools to monitor optical module status:

- Cisco Switches:** Use the web-based utility to view port number, module description, serial number, PID, voltage, temperature, and link status.
- Extreme Switches:** Check DDM (Digital Diagnostics Monitoring) parameters such as real-time transmit/receive optical power, temperature, and voltage. A "Normal" status indicates all parameters are within valid ranges.
- Huawei Switches:** Commands like `display transceiver interface xgigabitethernet 0/0/2 verbose` allow checking wavelength, received/transmitted po...
