Circuit breakers and fuses are designed to prevent overloads and short circuits, but they do not eliminate the risk of electric shock . Qualified electricians should perform any maintenance or modifications. Keep the area around the box clear and dry to reduce the risk of accidents.

Local distribution substations, which step down high-voltage electricity to normal mains voltage, are often located near homes. These substations supply electricity via underground or overhead lines to distribution boxes . While the electric and magnetic fields (EMFs) from these substations are generally low and considered safe at typical distances, the wires and equipment themselves carry live...
