AI Overview

Three switches can be connected using fiber optic cables in either a star or ring topology, with proper SFP modules and fiber type ensuring reliable communication.

Topology Options

Star Topology: Each remote switch connects directly to a central switch (core switch). Provides high performance and isolation; if one link fails, other switches remain unaffected. Requires one fiber strand per connection, so for three switches, three separate fibers or strands are needed ().

Ring Topology: Switches are connected in a loop, allowing data to travel in both directions. Offers redundancy; if one link fails, traffic can reroute the opposite way (). More complex to configure and may require ring protection protocols to prevent broadcast storms.

Daisy Chain (Cascading): Core switch connects to Switch A, which connects to Switch B, then Switch C. Simpler cabling but a failure in an intermediate switch can disrupt downstream connectivity ().

Fiber and SFP Considerations

Fiber Type: Single-mode fiber is suitable for long distances; multi-mode fiber is used for shorter runs ().

SFP Modules: Ensure SFPs match the fiber type (single-mode or multi-mode) and distance requirements (short-haul SX or long-haul LX) ().

Connectors: Common types include LC, SC, and ST; LC is compact and widely used in high-density setups ().

Polarity: Correct patch cable polarity is essential to bring up the link ().

Configuration Tips For physical layer connectivity, ports usually do not require configuration beyond ensuring they are not administratively shut down (). If using patch panels, verify that fiber strands are correctly connected and, if necessary, swapped to match transmit/receive pairs. Test each link individually before integrating all switches to ensure proper connectivity.
