Overview of the Three Levels

- 1. Main Distribution Box (Primary Distribution Box)** The main distribution box serves as the central hub, directly connected to the transformer's low-voltage side (typically 0.4kV) and distributing power to secondary distribution boxes. It does not supply power directly to end-use devices. Key components include isolating switches, circuit breakers, and residual current devices (RCDs) to ensure overall circuit safety. These boxes often feature copper busbars for optimal conductivity, front-opening doors, and rainproof tops for outdoor installations.
- 2. Secondary Distribution Box (Sub-Distribution Box)** Secondary distribution boxes receive power from the main distribution box and supply it to specific buildings, floors, or zones. They handle three-phase power and connect to heavier loads such as motors or machinery. These boxes are equipped with larger three-phase circuit breakers and often include dual-door protection, powder-coated exteriors, and rainproof designs for outdoor use. They form part of a layered protection system, providing intermediate safety before power reaches end-use equipment.
- 3. Tertiary Distribution Box (Switch Box or Final Distribution Box)** Tertiary distribution boxes are the final connection point for individual devices or household systems, delivering 220V single-phase power. They follow strict safety standards, implementing the principle of "one device, one circuit breaker, one RCD, one box" to ensure independent circuit protection. These boxes may be fixed or portable and include RCDs to provide two-layer protection alongside secondary distribution boxes.
