- POWER + LOS red/blinking:** Indicates a connectivity problem; inspect fiber cables, connectors, or contact your ISP.

Troubleshooting Steps

- Check Power:** Ensure the router is plugged in and the outlet is working.
- Inspect Fiber Cables:** Look for cuts, bends, or loose connections. Clean connectors if necessary.
- Restart Router:** Power cycle the router to resolve temporary glitches.
- Check ISP Status:** If lights appear normal but internet is unavailable, the issue may be with your service provider.
- Contact Support:** If the lights indicate a persistent problem (e.g., LOS), contact your ISP or router manufacturer for assistance.
