Perforated Trays These trays have a solid bottom with perforations, providing ventilation and drainage while supporting cables. They are widely used in commercial buildings and control rooms. The perforations help prevent overheating and allow smoke and heat to dissipate, enhancing fire safety.

Solid Bottom Trays Solid trays have no openings and provide complete protection for sensitive cables, such as data and control cables, shielding them from electromagnetic interference (EMI) and physical damage. They are often used in data centers and laboratories. While they protect cables, moisture accumulation can be an issue, which may require additional drainage solutions.

Basket (Wire Mesh) Trays Basket trays are lightweight, open-mesh structures that support control and communication cables. Their design allows easy horizontal and vertical adjustments, good ventilation, and effective heat dissipation. They are preferred for installations requiring frequent modifications or expansions.

Channel Trays Channel trays are U-shaped and provide support for small-capacity cables. They are suitable for confined spaces and short cable runs, offering moderate fire protection and structural support.

Materials and Fire Resistance Cable trays are manufactured from materials such as galvanized steel, stainless steel, aluminum, PVC, and FRP/GRP. Each material has different thermal conductivity and fire performance characteristics:
