Lower Panel (Subpanel)
Function: Receives power from the main panel and distributes it to a subset of circuits, such as a specific floor, building wing, or specialized equipment.
Components: Circuit breakers, busbars, and neutral/ground connections; typically does not include a main breaker if fed from a main panel.
Applications: Used to reduce wiring complexity, localize control, and improve safety by isolating circuits for maintenance.
Installation Considerations: Requires proper feeder wiring from the main panel and correct neutral-to-ground separation to comply with electrical codes.
