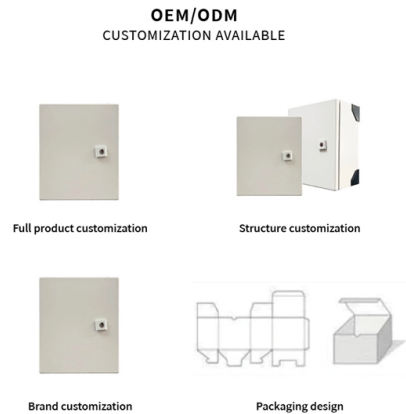


Various bends in cable trays 90° bends

These bends maintain structural integrity while allowing efficient cable routing.

Radius and Custom Bends Some 90-degree bends are designed with a radius to create a smooth curve rather than a sharp angle. Custom radius bends are ideal for installations around columns or irregular spaces, ensuring cables are not stressed and maintain proper alignment.

Adjustable bends are also available for medium and heavy-duty trays, allowing configurations from 30° up to 90°.

Additional Variations Reducer-type bends connect trays of different widths while maintaining smooth cable transitions. Horizontal cross junctions can create multiple 90-degree paths on the same plane for complex routing.

Material considerations include mild steel (pre-galvanized or hot-dip galvanized) and stainless steel (316L), with options for ventilated or closed covers. These types of 90-degree bends ensure that cable trays can navigate complex layouts efficiently while protecting cables from sharp b...
