Thermal Stripping Thermal or thermo-mechanical strippers use heat to soften the polymer coating before removal. This method is particularly effective for tight-buffered cables where the coating adheres strongly to the fiber. By softening the coating, thermal strippers reduce the risk of fiber damage and provide a cleaner, more precise strip. These tools are more expensive and require a power source but offer higher precision and consistency.

Chemical Stripping Chemical stripping involves using solvents or acids to dissolve the polymer coating. This method is less common in field applications due to safety concerns and handling requirements but can be effective for specialty fibers or when mechanical stripping is impractical. Proper ventilation, protective gloves, and eye protection are essential when using chemical methods.

Non-Contact Methods Non-contact techniques, such as hot air or laser ablation, remove coatings without physically touching the fiber. These methods are precise and reduce the risk of mechanical damage, making them suitable for delicate or high-density fibers. They are typically used in laboratory or high-end manufacturing environments.
