For vertical risers, clamps and brackets must resist both the weight of the cables and any dynamic forces during installation or maintenance.
- Compliance with Standards:** Installations should conform to IEC 61537 or BS EN 61537, which define cable management systems, including trays and ladders, for electrical and communication systems. These standards ensure that trays are not used as walkways or ladders and that mechanical loads are safely supported.
- Installation Sequence:** Plan the vertical route considering building structure, clearances, and other services. Install vertical support brackets or strut channels first. Connect tray sections using bolted couplers and splice plates. Secure the tray with fixing clamps at each support point. Ensure proper alignment and tighten all fasteners.
