- 5. Bundle Carefully:** When tying multiple cables together, avoid over-tightening. Keep bundles loose enough to allow for expansion and movement, but organized to prevent tangling. Separate fiber bundles from heavier copper cables to avoid crushing.
- 6. Outdoor and Temporary Protection:** If cables are exposed outdoors or left on reels for extended periods, maintain protective sheathing and avoid prolonged exposure to sunlight or mechanical stress.
