detection/prevention, and content filtering—into a single platform, simplifying management while providing comprehensive protection.

4. **Network Access Control (NAC)** NAC devices enforce security policies by controlling which devices can access the network, ensuring that only compliant and authenticated devices are allowed entry.
5. **Virtual Private Network (VPN) Gateways** VPN gateways provide secure remote access by encrypting data transmitted over public networks, protecting sensitive information from interception.

6. **Email and Web Security Gateways** These devices filter malicious emails, phishing attempts, and harmful web content, preventing malware and social engineering attacks from reaching users.
7. **Endpoint Protection Devices** Endpoint security solutions protect individual devices such as co...
