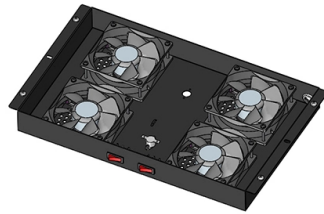


What are the different types of infrastructure in Indonesia

Energy: Indonesia is expanding power generation with thermal and hydropower plants, aiming to add 35 GW of new capacity by 2029. Projects like the Batang Power Plant leverage public-private partnerships to attract private investment while maintaining fiscal discipline.

Water and Irrigation: Infrastructure development includes dams, irrigation channels, and water treatment facilities to support agriculture, food security, and rural development.

Digital Connectivity: Efforts to expand ICT infrastructure enable rural households and businesses to access online services, improving education, commerce, and communication.
