Horizontal supports are typically made from steel, stainless steel, or aluminum, chosen based on strength requirements and environmental conditions. Mounting elements like screws, bolts, or J-bolts attach the supports to the building structure. Accessories such as covers or barrier strips may be added to protect cables.
