Access the ONU/Modem Interface: Connect a computer via Ethernet and log in to the device's web interface using its IP address.

Enable Bridge Mode: Locate the bridge mode, passthrough, or IP passthrough option in the advanced settings and enable it.

Connect Your Router: Plug your personal router into the ONU's Ethernet port. The router will now handle DHCP, NAT...
