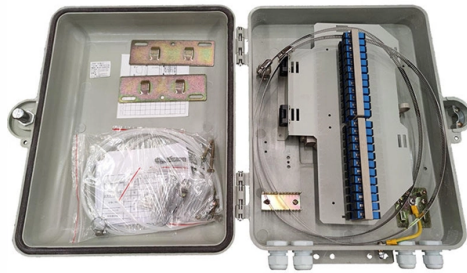


What is the depth of the distribution box



Overview

Typical wall-mount enclosure sizes often range from about 200 × 200 × 120 mm up to 800 × 600 × 300 mm. Freestanding cabinets commonly range from about 1600–2200 mm in height, 600–1800 mm in width, and 300–600 mm in depth. A distribution box is an essential device that manages the safe and efficient flow of electrical power throughout different areas of a building or facility. Most standard outlets use a single-gang box with at least 18 cubic inches of internal volume. The depth of an electrical box determines how much internal volume is available for conductors, grounding bars, and other components.
