

What is the safe distance from a distribution box



Overview

Quick Answer: High-voltage transmission lines on tall metal towers require at least 200 feet of distance to significantly reduce magnetic field exposure. Is distance satisfactory to protect power distribution boxes (breaker boxes, disconnects ranging from anywhere from 50 volts to 440 volts) from damage in active warehouses with stacked material, fork truck traffic, and pedestrian traffic; or does there need to be a protective barrier?

If distance. For a common 15 kV distribution line, the minimum safe distance is about 2 feet 2 inches from the conductor for phase-to-ground exposure; for a 345 kV transmission line, that distance jumps to over 11 feet. These numbers come directly from tables published by OSHA under 29 CFR 1910. 269 and 29 CFR. Electrical clearances set the minimum safe distances for panels, overhead lines, pools, and buried wiring — and ignoring them has real consequences.
