

What level of electrical distribution box is the power box

The distribution box is a level 1 power distribution facility in the power supply system. The outgoing line from the low-voltage end of the transformer is 0.4kV to the distribution cabinet (primary distribution cabinet), then the outgoing line is led to the distribution box (secondary distribution box) in each building, and finally the outgoing line is led to the distribution cabinet.
