This characteristic allows it to tightly wrap around electrical conductors and termination part, providing insulation, weather stability and chemical resistance. Heat-shrink tubing is ordinarily made of a polyolefin, which shrinks radially (but not longitudinally) when heated, to between one-half and one-sixth of its diameter. Most heat shrink tubing is made of polyolefin, a family of plastics that includes polyethylene and polypropylene. But heat shrink also comes in PVC, fluoropolymers like.
