Update Firmware Outdated router firmware can sometimes cause connectivity issues. Use your router's app or web interface to check for and install any pending updates.

Reset the Router (if necessary) Locate the reset button on the router, usually a small hole labeled "Reset." Press and hold the button for 10-30 seconds using a paperclip or pin. Be aware that this will erase custom settings, so have your ISP credentials ready to reconfigure the router.

Contact Your ISP If the above steps do not resolve the issue, contact your ISP. Provide them with: The LOS light status (blinking or solid red) Observations about the cables or router Your account details for faster support
