- PVC Conduit (Schedule 40/80):** Non-metallic, corrosion-resistant, and cost-effective, commonly used underground or in dry environments. Requires UV protection if exposed outdoors.
- Liquidtight Flexible Non-Metallic Conduit (LFNC):** Flexible, non-metallic option for wet or outdoor areas, providing waterproof protection for wiring.
