Devices That Interface With Fiber Panels Beyond connectors, fiber panels can interface with network devices via fiber cables:

- Fiber media converters:** Convert fiber signals to copper Ethernet and vice versa, extending network reach or isolating electrical surges.
- Fiber switches:** Allow multiple fiber connections to form a network, similar to Ethernet switches but for optical signals.
- Fiber network adapters:** Enable direct fiber connections to computers or servers, supporting fiber-to-the-desktop (FTTD) setups.
- Optical transceivers (SFP/SFP+/QSFP):** Pluggable modules that connect fiber cables to switches, routers, or servers, often inserted into ports on the panel or connected devices.
