Most residential fiber installations use single-mode SC/APC connectors, which connect the fiber from the wall outlet to the ONT. The ONT then converts the optical signal into an electrical signal that your router can use. Connecting Fiber to a Router Install the ONT: Plug the fiber cable from the wall outlet into the ONT's SC/APC port. Power on the ONT and wait for the status lights to stabilize. Connect the ONT to the Router: Use an Ethernet cable from the ONT's LAN port to the router's WAN port. Most consumer routers do not have direct fiber ports, so the ONT acts as the intermediary. Router Configuration: Power on the router and ensure it recognizes the connection. Some ISPs may require specific SFP modules or compatible routers for...
