- FC (Ferrule Connector):** Screw-on, ideal for high-vibration environments, less common today.
- ST (Straight Tip):** Bayonet mount, legacy or industrial LAN applications.
- MPO/MTP (Multi-Fiber Push-On):** Multi-fiber connectors (8, 12, 24 fibers), essential for high-density parallel optics like 40G/100G deployments.

- MU, MT-RJ, E2000, DIN connectors** for specialized or legacy systems.
- Polish Types**
- PC (Physical Contact):** Slightly spherical end-face, reduces air gap, return loss $\sim -40\text{dB}$.
- UPC (Ultra Physical Contact):** Extended polish for better surface finish, return loss $\sim -55\text{dB}$, common in digital applications.
- APC (Angled Physical Contact):** 8° angled polish, minimizes back-reflection, used in high-performance or analog systems.

- Simplex:** Single fiber, one-way transmission.
- Duplex:** Two fibers, bidirectional communication.
- Armored:** Steel sheath for rodent and crush protection in harsh environments.
- Bend-Insensitive Fiber (BIF):** Tolerates tight bends with minima...
