

Wiring Fiber Optic Firewall and Switch



AI Overview

To connect fiber optic internet to a firewall and switch, use an SFP-enabled port on the switch or a media converter, then link the firewall and switch via Ethernet uplinks, ensuring proper duplex fiber connections and VLAN configuration.

Connecting Fiber Optic to Your Firewall/Router
Fiber Input: Most fiber connections require an Optical Network Terminal (ONT) provided by your ISP. The fiber cable (typically SC/APC or SC/UPC) plugs into the ONT.
Router/Firewall Connection: If your firewall or router has an SFP port, you can connect the fiber directly. Otherwise, use a media converter to convert fiber to copper Ethernet.
Power and Initialization: Power on the ONT and firewall/router, and wait for status lights to stabilize, indicating a successful link.

Connecting the Firewall to the Switch
Use a standard Ethernet uplink from the firewall's LAN port to a port on the switch. This allows internal devices to access the internet while the firewall manages NAT, VLANs, and security rules. Ensure the switch port is configured as an uplink and, if using VLANs, that the firewall is set to route traffic appropriately between LAN, DMZ, and WAN segments.

Connecting Switches via Fiber
For long-distance or high-bandwidth connections between switches, use duplex fiber optic cabling with SFP or SFP+ transceivers. Ensure the fiber strands are correctly paired: send on port A connects to receive on port B and vice versa. Choose the SFP module type based on your fiber: single-mode (OS2) for long distances or multimode (OM3/OM4) for shorter distances. Pre-terminated fiber cables with LC connectors simplify installation and reduce errors.

Network Topology Considerations
Star topology is recommended for performance: all devices connect to a central switch, reducing collisions and simplifying management. If multiple VLANs or WAN traffic need to traverse a single fiber link, configure trunk ports on the switches and ensure the firewall handles NAT and routing. Avoid connecting WAN traffic directly to a switch without firewall processing, as L2 switches cannot perform...
