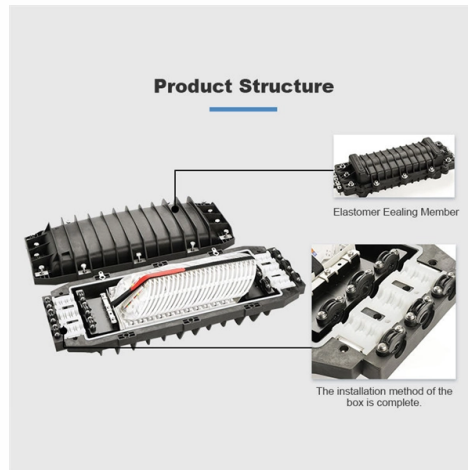


Wiring from the distribution box to the control panel

Connect Ground Wires: Connect all ground wires from the control panel to the ground bus bar in the distribution box, which is bonded to a grounding rod or water pipe to prevent electric shocks.

Verify Connections and Test: Double-check all connections for tightness and correct placement.
