

Wiring of the secondary distribution box circuit

- Branch Breakers:** Connect each branch circuit's phase wire to the corresponding breaker. The neutral wire of each circuit is connected to the neutral bar, and the ground wire to the ground bar.
- RCCB/RCD (if used):** For additional protection against leakage currents, connect the output of the main breaker to the RCCB, then feed the branch breakers from the RCCB.

Wiring Direction and Organization: Typically, wiring from the main breaker to branch breakers runs on the left side, and outgoing wires to loads exit on the right. Use plastic ties to bind wires neatly, maintaining uniform spacing and straight runs.

Labeling: Clearly mark each breaker and circuit to indicate the area or appliance it controls for easy maintenance and troubleshooting.

Safety Inspection: After wiring, check for short circuits, proper grounding, and correct breaker ratings to ensure safety.
