

Wiring of the three-level distribution box and switch box

A three-level distribution system requires hierarchical wiring from the main distribution board to secondary distribution boards and finally to switch boxes, ensuring balanced load, safety, and compliance with electrical standards.

Main Distribution Board (DB) Wiring

The main distribution board serves as the central hub for power distribution. In a three-phase system, it receives three live conductors (L1, L2, L3), a neutral, and an earth from the incoming supply . Key steps include:

- Main Switch/MCCB:** Connect the incoming supply to a 3-pole or 4-pole MCCB, which acts as the main isolator .
- Busbars:** Use copper or aluminum busbars to distribute power from the main switch to outgoing circuit breakers, ensuring high current capacity and minimal voltage drop .
- MCBs and RCCBs:** Connect outgoing circuits to 3-pole MCBs for three-phase loads. RCCBs can be installed after the main MCCB for additional earth fault protection .
- Neutral and Earth Links:** Connect all neutral wires to a neutral busbar and all earth wires to an earth busbar. Multiple links should be interconnected for consistency .
- Labeling:** Clearly label each phase, neutral, and earth terminal to facilitate maintenance and prevent errors .

Secondary Distribution Boards and Switch Boxes

In a three-level distribution system, hierarchical wiring is essential :

- Tertiary Switch Boxes:** Each switch box should control only one piece of equipment or socket (“one machine, one switch” principle). No branching is allowed from switch boxes to multiple devices .
- Separation of Circuits:** Power and lighting circuits should be separated, with dedicated distribution boards and switch boxes for each type .
- Minimizing Distances:** The distance from the main DB to secondary DBs should not exceed 30 meters, and from switch boxes to controlled equipment should ideally be under 3 meters .
- Environmental Safety:** Install boards and switch boxes in dry, ventil...
